What is PATH Community Engagement?

Kentucky HEALTH is the Commonwealth's new program for certain people on Medicaid. Some Kentucky HEALTH beneficiaries will need to complete 80 hours of PATH Community Engagement activities each month to keep their Medicaid benefits.



80 hours

Who has a PATH Community Engagement requirement?

- Income-Eligible Adults
- Income-Eligible Caretaker Relatives of a Child

- Pregnant Women
- Medically Frail
- Former Foster Youth up to age 26
- Children
- Full-time students
- Primary caregivers of a dependent
- People who are employed full-time

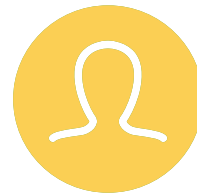
