

PATH Community Engagement Rollout Schedule

The PATH Community Engagement requirement will be implemented across the Commonwealth by region between July 1, 2018 and December 1, 2018.

PATH stands for “**Partnering to Advance Training and Health**” and refers to the Community Engagement part of the Kentucky HEALTH program. **Some** adults will need to complete 80 hours each month of approved PATH Community Engagement activities to continue getting Medicaid through Kentucky HEALTH.

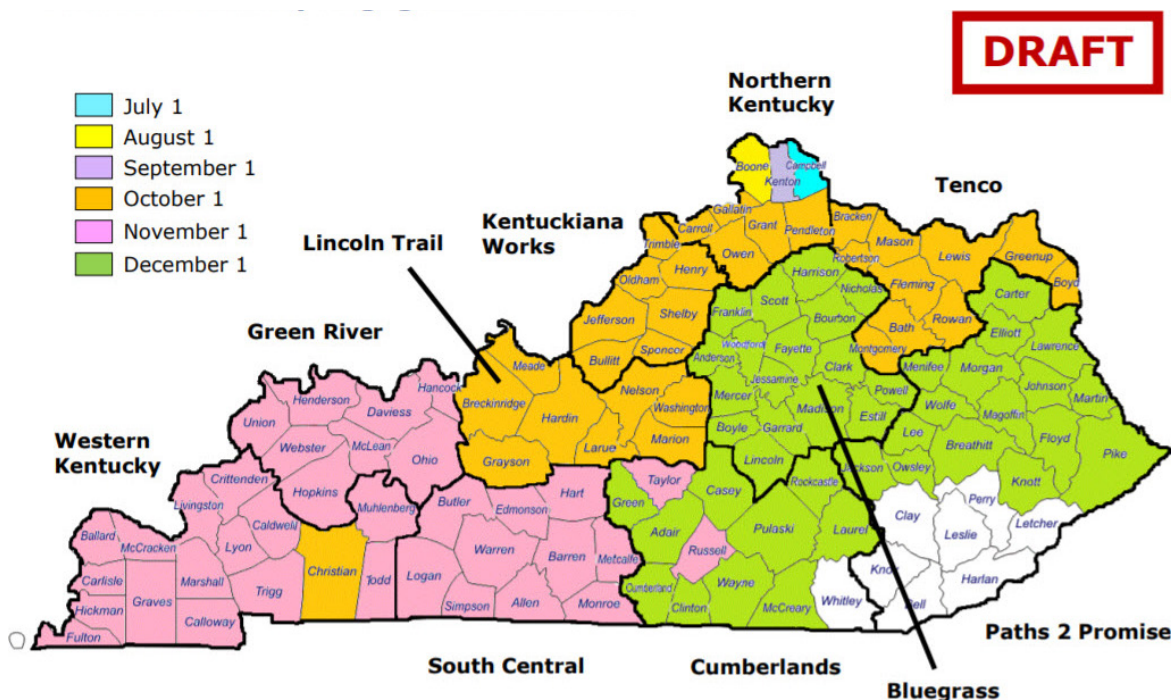
PATH Community Engagement is:

- **REQUIRED** for most Kentucky adults (ages 19-64) on Medicaid who are able to work.
- **NOT REQUIRED** for Medicaid recipients who are pregnant, medically frail, disabled, primary caregivers of a dependent, or former foster care youth up to age 26.

Activities that count towards the PATH Community Engagement requirement include: **working, looking for a job, training for a new job or skill, attending classes, volunteering, caretaking, and participating in substance use disorder treatment.**

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Below is the PATH rollout schedule, as of June 18, 2018. Please note this is subject to change.



*The counties labeled white are Paths 2 Promise counties. These counties are exempt from the PATH requirement through 2018. Additional information on requirements for these counties will be provided at a later date.
